A Little Bit About Us

Puckihuddle Preschool was established in 1981. Our program provides children and their families a high-quality early childhood experience. Our classes are led by dedicated professionals who, through guidance, patience and understanding, will motivate, encourage and inspire each child's desire to learn.

Lunch Bunch

Lunch Bunch includes 60-minutes of supervised lunch (parent-provided) and play. Lunch Bunch can be a wonderful opportunity to extend your child's day. During lunch Bunch students refine their self-help skills by opening lunch containers, practice advocating for themselves by asking for help when needed and get to socialize with their peers. Lunch Bunch is available every day for our half-day students. Families will be able to sign up their child via signup genius. The cost for Lunch Bunch will be \$10 per day. Parents will have the flexibility to sign up for one day at a time or many days each month. Advanced registration will be required so staffing and activities can be planned accordingly.

If you are interested in enrolling your child, a \$75 non-refundable registration fee is due when you enroll to secure your child's spot.

Our Curriculum & Learning Activities

We believe children learn best through play.

Our curriculum is child centered with developmentally appropriate materials which encourage creativity, problem solving skills, and a love of learning. The children learn teamwork and respect for the needs and feelings of others. Limits are set in ways that develop self-control and preserve self-esteem. Each session is carefully planned around a unit of study with the age and skills of the group in mind.

We believe children learn best by doing.

Therefore, our structured, yet flexible daily schedule is filled with hands-on learning activities. There is a delicate balance between child-initiated and teacher guided activities as well as time for individual, small group and large group instruction. We incorporate art, blocks, books, cooking, dramatic play, small and large motor, games, language and literacy, math explorations, music & movement, nutrition, outdoor play, puppets, puzzles, science discoveries, and sensory play into our day. Each of these learning centers provides a place for children to explore, imagine and grow. Reading, writing, math, science, and social studies skills are a major focus of our program and are incorporated into our thematic curriculum during our meeting times, carefully planned lessons and learning activities.

We believe in each child's individuality. Each child is unique and we want to nurture the individual spirit. We are prepared to meet the individual needs of your child and help achieve their highest potential by fostering curiosity, extending their thinking and making learning FUN!

Health & Safety

Puckihuddle Preschool is following all of EEC guidelines to create and maintain the safest possible environment for all of our students and staff. Some of these safety precautions consist of HEPA air purifiers, individual sensory and media boxes, increasing ventilation, rotation of toys throughout the school day, disinfectant fogger, acrylic dividers and classrooms arranged to allow for natural social distancing.
